Question:

1. Are you willing to learn more from the bible than what your "church" teaches, or wants you to know? Yes _____ No _____.

The reason I ask this is that most organized religions, from the top down rule, are prone to limit their members growth, to understand only so far as they teach. If you disagree with them they may be very unacceptable to any truths you present to them. I've been there and done that! Trust me. Should we support anyone who would suppress our spiritual growth? Yes _____ no _____.

2. Do you have a driving "hunger" to learn all there is to know about the Bible and the Creator? Yes _____ No _____ If yes, to what limits are you willing to go to learn this? Are you willing to follow the Apostles' example and suffer persecution for what Yahweh reveals to you? Yes _____ No _____. Be honest!

You will notice I used the term "Yeshua" for Jesus and "Yahweh" for God. That was their names before their names were translated into English. It's not wrong to use the translations, but I like the original names. Of course both Yeshua, the Messiah and Yahweh, the Father, have many, many names (in the original) that describe their natures and offices.

3. Another very important question: Are you being taught, and accept, that the O.T. laws have been done away with because Yeshua fulfilled them? Yes _____ No _____.

To many religious organizations the term "fulfilled" means "done away with" and they go to great lengths to "prove" their belief. However, the word "fulfilled" simply means Yeshua carried out what He came to do. He himself said He did not come to change any of his Father's laws. It is also important to realize that there was no "New Testament" during the time of Yeshua, or during the New Testament church which was established by the teachings done by the apostles directly from the O.T. These were the scriptures Yeshua referred to in Mat. 5:17 when He said: ¶ Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill. (Do what the prophets said I would do).

Mat. 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. (not everything has been accomplished yet that was prophesied in the O.T.)

19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. Yeshua said in Mat. 19:7 that the way to "enter into life" is to keep the commandments. And Paul told Timothy in 2Tim 3:16 that ALL scripture (referring to the O.T.) is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness". Do you believe them? Yes ____ No ____.

4. Do you believe Yehweh requires you to keep His Laws, the Ten Commandments, as set forth in the scriptures? Yes _____ No _____.

If you said yes, then you must also be keeping the Sabbath as set forth in the bible, not the one the Catholic Church proclaimed, Sunday, which most Protestants have accepted and keep. How can we know where Sunday observance originated? Not from the bible. From the Catholic Encyclopedia. They admit that they did it! How can we know which day Yeshua kept? He kept the same day as the Jews kept, as the scriptures show, and still keep today, the 7th day (Saturday), from sundown the evening before to the sundown of the 7th day, by Jerusalem time, not the first day of the week (Sunday).

You will be surprised at the mistakes the translators made when they changed the Hebrew or Greek into the English language. If you look up the word "Easter" for instance, you will find it was originally "Passover". This book tells the meaning of every word in the Bible in it's original Hebrew or Greek meaning, I am constantly using mine for my studies.
