What do you understand about:

2. What happens to "The Rest of the Dead" that Rev.20 talks about that were not resurrected until after the thousand year millennium?
3. Why did Paul preach to the Gentiles, saying Israel has been blinded (spiritually) by God who has turned to the Gentiles? Rom 11.
4. Where in the new testament, AFTER the resurrection of Jesus, where do we find instructions as to how tithes are to be paid, and to who? (Not about physical lodging and food while ministering to the churches)
5. Why are there no end of our age Israelite churches given a message from Jesus? Rev. 2 and 3. All the churches mentioned are Gentile churches in Asia.
6. If grace does away with works, how does that work?
7. What day did Jesus keep for the Sabbath?
8. What is a soul?
9. Explain the Bible definition of "begotten" apposed to "born-again"
10. What advise did Peter give for anyone to be saved?

If anyone can give me these (just 5) answers correctly, using scriptures to prove the point, I will be more than happy to support their teaching, if not, I will know they are not ready to teach others. For this reason I must not support them. This does not mean if they have obeyed acts 2:38. they should give up, because this is the beginning of life eternal. We all had to start somewhere.
