

SURPRISE, SURPRISE! From The Bible

DO YOU KNOW?:

1. From the time of the resurrection of Jesus, in the New Testament, there is no command for Christians to TITHE anywhere, not even Paul, who was called to teach God's Word to the Gentiles, taught it to them? I challenge anyone to refute! Tithe Paying is not required in this age because when Jesus became 'the first-born' of many brethren, He also became the High Priest, replacing the Priestly system, meaning there is no longer a need for people to support the Priests with tithes. Neither was there a Temple to be supported, as was originally instituted, by taxes and support. Neither did Paul teach tithe paying for any church. There is encouragement to give and share but not tithing.
2. The Bible teaches there is NO END OF TIME? The Bible teaches there is no end of God's Kingdom and that the righteous will live for all eternity (forever). Eternal life must never end for this promise of eternal life to be fulfilled.
3. There was NO NEW TESTAMENT during the ministry of Jesus or the Apostles? They taught strictly from the Old Testament! When Jesus said, "keep the commandments" he was referring to the Ten Commandments in the O.T.
4. There are some MISTAKES in the Bible? Yes, the Bible was originally written in Hebrew and Greek, translated by many men into several languages and some minor mistakes were made. However, God has made it clear that there are ways to find out what these mistakes are, by serious study, comparing questionable mistakes with what the Bible says about the same subject in other places. One modern help is found by using Strong's Complete Concordance, which gives English definitions of the original Hebrew and Greek languages. This book can be purchased at Christian book stores.
5. Jesus did not do away with the LAWS of His Father? He taught from the O.T. and said he came to make the law more binding. In other words the law was changed from keeping it by the actual letter to the spiritual desire to want to keep it. If one "hates" another it is a sin, even if he doesn't commit murder. Both "sin against the law".
6. The law IS NOT A CURSE?. The curse "of the law" was when, according to the old Covenant, those who broke the law were under the (eternal) death penalty. That is why sin offerings were made once a year for Israel's sins. This animal sacrifice represented Christ's death, who would become the sacrifice for mankind's sins under certain conditions. a) first, they must recognize what sin is b) repent, stop committing those sins, and c) hold out (in faith) to the very end.
7. FAITH IS BELIEVING GOD? Without faith you cannot please God! To believe God one has to first learn what to believe. To learn what to believe one has to study the Bible and do what it says. Ignorance is no excuse to God because He has preserved this knowledge for most people. However God does look on the attitude. If one obeys everything he learns to do with the desire to learn more He will work with them. God is patient and merciful with the pure in heart (right attitude).
8. That Jesus comes as a WARRIOR and fights against the wicked at His first return? Yes, He brings His army with Him and fights against those nations who have rebelled against Him, and He wins. Read about it in the book of Revelation.

9. The BATTLE OF ARMAGEDDON is not between nations but between nations and the King of kings? If someone says this is not true you can know they don't know what the Bible says. The battle of Armageddon is fought between Christ and the remaining wicked nations.

10. If someone teaches that we can expect Yeshua to come at any time you can know that person does not know the scriptures? Much of the Book of Revelation has yet to be fulfilled before Yeshua returns. There are lots of things to happen yet, but mine and your life could end at any time; that would be, if we make it into the first resurrection, the next thing we will know.
