

EVENTS TO TAKE PLACE BEFORE CHRIST RETURNS

It is possible to know, not when Christ will appear, but what will happen before he returns. This study will give you the exact events, in order, to take place in the book of Revelation where you can find this information. For lack of space I will only give a minimum amount of quotes on each event, leaving the reader to select the verses to read the rest. I have been reminded by a minister that he is more interested in making people feel good instead of supporting negative studies. I am convinced our house is on fire and Jesus is warning us to look, watch, be prepared. It is wonderful to rejoice in Jesus' love and pretend we are all safe in our salvation, all the time ignoring his warning that harder times will come, our house may already be on fire.

This is not a message from me. This is a letter, of future events, from our savior, Jesus Christ, that he is sending to his churches. He is allowing us, who take his love letter to his beloved church seriously, to glimpse into the future. It is a plea to his people to be prepared to fight against an evil world, as he pleads, "come out of her my people".

We will find where Christ tells us in detail what to look for so we can know what is going to happen in the future. He says we are now just in the beginning of sorrows. People's houses, all around us, are already burning down! Whether we like it or not ours is about ready to burn too. Jesus loves us, that is why he is sending Revelation's message to any who will listen. He is warning us not to slumber and sleep like the virgins did, who had no oil in their lamps, while waiting for him to return.

The list of events, in chronological order are as listed below.

1. Rev. 8:7 Here we read about: All green grass will be burned. Hail, fire, and blood.
2. Rev. 8:8-9 A great burning mountain falls into into sea, killing 1/3 of water life, and turns 1/3 water to blood.
3. Rev. 8:10-11 A great star falls poisoning the water.
4. Rev.8:12 Sun and moon turns dark every day 1/3 of day and every night.
5. Rev. 9:1-6 Poison locust stings people with scorpion like pain. They torture for 5 months.
6. Rev. 9:12-18 Four angels, for over 13 years, kills 1/3 of man, with 2 million men army.

7. Rev. 11:3-13 The two witnesses preach in Jerusalem for 3 1/2 years, are murdered and resurrected before the world to watch. A great earthquake kills 1,000 people.

8. Rev. 13:2-18 One world government by Beast power. Great persecution to believers. One world religion is described in 17:1-11, the 10 kings who destroy it. 17:13-17

9. Rev. 14:6-20 Angels preach last call to repentance. ver.1-5 John sees in vision 144,000 redeemed who have God the Father's name written in their foreheads.

10. Rev. 16:2-21 God pours out His final wrath on a wicked world, in seven time periods. Then God destroys his demon enemies during the battle of Armageddon. Greatest earthquake ever, destroys the great city of Babylon. No more mountains, Island, and 130lb hail stones fall.

11. Rev.19:1-21 CHRIST RETURNS as King of Kings followed by an army. They destroy the beast and false prophet and all the wicked and feed them to the fowls of the earth.

12. Rev. 20:1-6 Last, but not least, he imprisons Satan for 1000 years. Judges were seen sitting on thrones judging. Those who had been beheaded for their faithfulness would rule in the earth with Christ for 1000 years. This is the first resurrection.

But all the rest of the dead would not be resurrected until after the 1000 years. Read about the resurrection of Whole House Israel in Eze. 37.
