Heb 1:9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows. Here we have the Father who is God calling His Son God and then the Father says I am your God. The Father is called God and the Son is called God. Joh 20:28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God. Thomas call Jesus God. (read 20:17) God means divine and both are divine. 1Jn 4:12 No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us. No man has Seen the Father at any time they have seen the Son Joh 1:18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him. No man has Seen the Father at any time they have seen the Son. Did you know the Son of God has been called an angel? Angel just means messenger. The Son of God carried His Father's message. Dan 3:25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God. Son of God was in the fire. Dan 3:28 Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God. The Father's angel (messenger) was in the fire. Act 27:23 For there stood by me this night the angel of God, whose I am, and whom I serve, Paul was saying that He was serving an angel and he belonged to that angel. This is the messenger of the Father who is the Son of God. Pro 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter."

Mal 2:10 Have we not all one father? hath not one God created us? why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the covenant of our fathers?

Mr 12:32 And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he:

Ro 3:30 Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.

1Co 8:6 But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.

Eph 4:6 One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

1Ti 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

God, the Father is above all gods. Jesus is the mediator between God and men. Even demons now this.

Jas 2:19 Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

Ex 34:14 For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God:

1Co 8:4 As concerning therefore the eating of those things that are offered in sacrifice unto idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is none other God but one.

Ex 5:1 And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto me in the wilderness.

Page after page in the Old Testament refers to "the God of Israel". During the second age God only had a relationship with the whole house of Israel.

Israel knew him as "the God of heaven and earth".

Ezr 5:11 And thus they returned us answer, saying, We are the servants of the God of heaven and earth, and build the house that was builded these many years ago, which a great king of Israel builded and set up.

Ezr 5:12 But after that our fathers had provoked the God of heaven unto wrath, he gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, the Chaldean, who destroyed this house, and carried the people away into Babylon.

Ne 1:4 And it came to pass, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned certain days, and fasted, and prayed before the God of heaven,

Ne 1:5 And said, I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his commandments:

Ac 24:14 But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:

If you believe the New Testament is God's message to us, then you also have to believe the Old Testament is also God's message to us, as Paul did. Paul wrote a big part of the New Testament!
