Deuteronomy 6:4-5 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. Psalm 1:1-2 But know that the Lord hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the Lord will hear when I call unto him. Psalm 4:3 I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, Lord, only makest me dwell in safety. Psalm 4:8 Give ear to my words, O Lord, consider my meditation. Harken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I pray. Psalm 5:1-2 What is man, that thou art mindful of him? And the son of man, that thou visitest him? For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honor. Psalm 8:4-5 O Lord our Lord, how majestic is thy name in all the earth! Psalm 8:9 The Lord also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. Psalm 9:9 The Lord is king forever and ever: the heathen are perished out of his land. Psalm 10:16 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament showeth his handiwork. Psalm 19:1 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the Lord: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before thee. Psalm 22:27 The earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. Psalm 24:1 Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O Lord. Psalm 25:7 The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? Psalm 27:1 Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord. Psalm 27:14 The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him. Psalm 28:7 The Lord will give strength unto his people; the Lord will bless his people with peace. Psalm 29:11 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the Lord. Psalm 31:24 Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Psalm 32:1 Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy. Psalm 33:18 I will bless the Lord at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth. Psalm 34:1 O magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt his name together. Psalm 34:3 The angel of the Lord encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them. Psalm 34:7 Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it. Psalm 34:14 The face of the Lord is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth. Psalm 34:16 The righteous cry, and the Lord heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles. Psalm 34:17 The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. Psalm 34:18 Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all. Psalm 34:19 The Lord redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate. Psalm 34:22 Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil. For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the Lord, they shall inherit the earth. Psalm 37:8,9 But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace. Psalm 37:11 And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the Lord. Psalm 40:3 Blessed is he that considereth the poor: the Lord will deliver him in time of trouble. Psalm 41:1 Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting, and to everlasting. Amen, and Amen. Psalm 41:13 My soul thirsteth for God, for the living God: when shall I come and appear before God? Psalm 42:2 God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Psalm 46:1 There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. Psalm 46:4 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth. Psalm 46:10 According to thy name, O God,

so is thy praise unto the ends of the earth: thy right hand is full of righteousness. Psalm 48:10 But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me. Psalm 48:15 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Psalm 51:10 When I cry unto thee, then shall mine enemies turn back: this I know; for God is for me. Psalm 56:9 In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me. Psalm 56:11 Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens; let thy glory be above all the earth. Psalm 57:5 Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer. From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock that is higher than I. Psalm 61:1-2 O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee. Psalm 69:5 So we thy people and sheep of thy pasture will give thee thanks for ever: we will show forth thy praise to all generations. Psalm 79:13 For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee. Psalm 86:5 So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom. Psalm 90:12 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. Psalm 91:1 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. Psalm 91:11-12 The Lord knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity. Psalm 94:11 O come, let us sing unto the Lord: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. Psalm 95:1-2 For the Lord is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations. Psalm 100:5 Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Psalm 103:1 The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. Psalm 103:8 He will not always chide: neither will he keep his anger for ever. Psalm 103:9 For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. Psalm 103:11 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth forever. Psalm 111:10 From the rising of the sun to the going down of the same the Lord's name is to be praised. Psalm 113:3 Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his saints. Psalm 116:15 This is the day which the Lord hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. Psalm 118:24 Thou art my God, and I will praise thee: thou art my God, I will exalt thee. Psalm 118:28 O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy endureth forever. Psalm 118:29 Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed thereto according to thy word. Psalm 119:9 Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law. Psalm 119:18 The earth, O Lord, is full of thy mercy: teach me thy statutes. Psalm 119:64 Thy faithfulness is unto all generations: thou hast established the earth, and it abideth. Psalm 119:90 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path. Psalm 119:105 Thou art my hiding place and my shield: I hope in thy word. Psalm 119:80 The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple. Psalm 119:130 He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber. Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. Psalm 121:3,4 The Lord shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore. Psalm 121:8 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee. Psalm 122:6 I wait for the Lord, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope. Psalm 130:5 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! Psalm 133:1 Behold, bless ye the Lord, all ye servants of the Lord, which by night stand in the house of the Lord. Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, and bless the Lord. Psalm 134:1-2 Praise the Lord; for the Lord is good: sing praises unto his name; for it is pleasant. Psalm 135:3 O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever. Psalm 136:1 I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy loving-kindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name. Psalm 138:2 Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and thy right hand shall save me. Psalm 138:7 Whither shall I go from thy spirit? Or whither shall I flee from thy presence? If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: If I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. Psalm 139:7,8 Search

me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: and see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. Psalm 139:23,24 Great is our Lord, and of great power: his understanding is infinite. Psalm 147:5 Let every thing that hath breath praise the Lord. Praise ye the Lord. Psalm 150:6 Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. Proverbs 3:5 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. Proverbs 3:6 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the Lord, and depart from evil. Proverbs 3:7 The Lord by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath he established the heavens. By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the dew. Proverbs 3:19,20 Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil men. Avoid it, pass not by it, turn from it, and pass away. Proverbs 4:14,15 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding. Proverbs 9:10 The Lord will not suffer the soul of the righteous to famish: but he casteth away the substance of the wicked. Proverbs 10:3 Blessings are upon the head of the just: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked. The memory of the just is blessed: but the name of the wicked shall rot. Proverbs 10:6,7 He that walketh uprightly walketh surely: but he that perverteth his ways shall be known. Proverbs 10:9 Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins. Proverbs 10:12 As the whirlwind passeth, so is the wicked no more: but the righteous is an everlasting foundation. Proverbs 10:25 The fear of the Lord prolongeth days: but the years of the wicked shall be shortened. Proverbs 10:27 When pride cometh, then cometh shame: but with the lowly is wisdom. Proverbs 11:2 The wicked worketh a deceitful work: but to him that soweth righteousness shall be a sure reward. Proverbs 11:18 The light of the righteous rejoiceth: but the lamp of the wicked shall be put out. Proverbs 13:9 Whoso despiseth the word shall be destroyed: but he that feareth the commandment shall be rewarded. Proverbs 13:13 Evil pursueth sinners: but to the righteous good shall be repaid. Proverbs 13:21 He that walketh in his uprightness feareth the Lord: but he that is perverse in his ways despiseth him. Proverbs 14:2 A scorner seeketh wisdom, and findeth it not: but knowledge is easy unto him that understandeth. Proverbs 14:6 There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death. Proverbs 14:12 The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death. Proverbs 14:27 The eyes of the Lord are in every place, beholding the evil and the good. Proverbs 15:3 The way of the wicked is an abomination unto the Lord: but he loveth him that followeth after righteousness. Proverbs 15:9 All the ways of a man are clean in his own eyes; but the Lord weigheth the spirits. Proverbs 16:2 Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established. Proverbs 16:3 Pride goeth before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall. Proverbs 16:18 Understanding is a wellspring of life unto him that hath it: but the instruction of fools is folly. Proverbs 16:22 The name of the Lord is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe. Proverbs 18:10 He that answereth a matter before he heareth it, it is folly and shame unto him. Proverbs 18:13 He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the Lord; and that which he hath given will he pay him again. Proverbs 19:17 Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise. Proverbs 20:1 Bread of deceit is sweet to a man; but afterward his mouth shall be filled with gravel. Proverbs 20:17 Whoso curseth his father or his mother, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness. Proverbs 20:20 Say not thou, I will recompense evil; but wait on the Lord, and he shall save thee. Proverbs 20:22 Every way of man is right in his own eyes: but the Lord pondereth the hearts. Proverbs 21:2 To do justice and judgment is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice. Proverbs 21:3 Whoso stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard. Proverbs 21:13 The man that wandereth out of the way of understanding shall remain in the congregation of the dead. Proverbs 21:16 The wicked shall be a ransom for the righteous, and the transgressor for the upright. Proverbs 21:18 He that followeth after righteousness and mercy findeth life, righteousness, and honor. Proverbs 21:21 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles. Proverbs 21:23 The rich and poor meet together: the Lord is the maker of them all. Proverbs 22:2 By humility and

the fear of the Lord are riches, and honor, and life. Proverbs 22:4 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. Proverbs 22:6 Bow down thine ear, and hear the words of the wise, and apply thine heart unto my knowledge. Proverbs 22:17 Let not thine heart envy sinners: but be thou in the fear of the Lord all the day long. For surely there is an end; and thine expectation shall not be cut off. Proverbs 23:17,18 Be not thou envious against evil men, neither desire to be with them. For their heart studieth destruction, and their lips talk of mischief. Proverbs 24:1,2 Rejoice not when thine enemy falleth, and let not thine heart be glad when he stumbleth: lest the Lord see it, and it displease him, and he turn away his wrath from him. Proverbs 24:17,18 Fret not thyself because of evil men, neither be thou envious at the wicked; for there shall be no reward to the evil man; the candle of the wicked shall be put out. Proverbs 24:19,20 Answer not a fool according to his folly, lest thou also be like unto him. Proverbs 26:4 As a dog returneth to his vomit, so a fool returneth to his folly. Proverbs 26:11 Seest thou a man wise in his own conceit? There is more hope of a fool than of him. Proverbs 26:12 Boast not thyself of tomorrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth. Proverbs 27:1 Hell and destruction are never full; so the eyes of man are never satisfied. Proverbs 27:20 He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy. Proverbs 28:13 Happy is the man that feareth always: but he that hardeneth his heart shall fall into mischief. Proverbs 28:14 Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. Proverbs 30:5 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. Isaiah 1:18 The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined. Isaiah 9:2 For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea. Isaiah 11:9 Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the Lord Jehovah is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation. Isaiah 12:2 And it shall come to pass in the day that the Lord shall give thee rest from thy sorrow, and from thy fear, and from the hard bondage wherein thou wast made to serve. Isaiah 14:3 He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord God will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the Lord hath spoken it. Isaiah 25:8 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. Isaiah 26:3 Trust ye in the Lord for ever: for in the Lord Jehovah is everlasting strength. Isaiah 26:4 And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever. Isaiah 32:17 The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God stands forever. Isaiah 40:8 He shall feed his flock like a shepherd: he shall gather the lambs with his arm, and carry them in his bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young. Isaiah 40:11 But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. Isaiah 40:31 Fear not: for I am with thee. Isaiah 43:5 I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed thee. Isaiah 44:22 Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else. Isaiah 45:22 Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the Lord hath comforted his people, and will have mercy upon his afflicted. Isaiah 49:13 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. Isaiah 53:5 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6 Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near. Isaiah 55:6 Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. Isaiah 55:7 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. Isaiah 55:8 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts. Isaiah 55:9 And the Lord shall guide thee

continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not. Isaiah 58:11 And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. Isaiah 65:24 Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord, and whose hope the Lord is. Jeremiah 17:7 The Lord thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing. Zephaniah 3:17 But he answered and said unto him, "It is written, man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God." Matthew 4:4 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:3 Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted. Matthew 5:4 Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. Matthew 5:5 Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. Matthew 5:6 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. Matthew 5:7 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God. Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. Matthew 5:9 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:10 Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. Matthew 5:11 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid. Matthew 5:14 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. Matthew 5:16 Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:20 Give to him that asketh thee, and from him that would borrow of thee turn not thou away. Matthew 5:42 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. Matthew 6:21 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. Matthew 6:24 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Matthew 6:33 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof. Matthew 6:34 Judge not, that ye be not judged. For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again. Matthew 7:1-2 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; Matthew 7:7 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him? Matthew 7:11 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets. Matthew 7:12 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it. Matthew 7:14 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves. Matthew 7:15 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Matthew 7:21 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give. Matthew 10:8 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves. Matthew 10:16 He that endureth to the end shall be saved. Matthew 10:22 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul; but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. Matthew 10:28 He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it. Matthew 10:39 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Matthew 11:28 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. Matthew 11:29-30 But I say unto you, that every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. Matthew 12:36 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. Matthew 12:37 Whosoever hath, to him shall be given, and he shall have more abundance: but whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken away even that he hath. Matthew

13:12 For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works. Matthew 16:27 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. Matthew 18:19 But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, "With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible." Matthew 19:26 Many that are first shall be last; and the last shall be first. Matthew 19:30 Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many. Matthew 20:28 And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive. Matthew 21:22 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, "All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth." Matthew 28:18 For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother. Mark 3:35 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? Mark 8:36 Jesus said unto him, "If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth." Mark 9:23 And Jesus answering said unto them, "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." Mark 12:17 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. Luke 1:33 And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise. Luke 6:31 Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned; forgive, and ye shall be forgiven. Luke 6:37 Rejoice not that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven. Luke 10:20 But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows. Luke 12:7 And which of you with taking thought can add to his stature one cubit? Luke 12:25 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Luke 12:32 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. Luke 12:34 Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not. Luke 12:40 Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth. Luke 15:10 Remember Lot's wife. Luke 17:32 Whosoever shall seek to save his life shall lose it; and whosoever shall lose his life shall preserve it. Luke 17:33 For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God. Luke 18:25 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away. Luke 21:33 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:1 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. John 1:3 In him was life; and the life was the light of men. John 3:3 Jesus answered, "Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God." John 3:5 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. John 3:16 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. John 3:17 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him. John 3:36 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life. John 4:14 God is a spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. John 4:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. John 5:24 Jesus answered and said unto them, "This is the work of God, that ye believe on him

whom he hath sent." John 6:29 And Jesus said unto them, "I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst." John 8:58 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. John 10:10 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. John 10:11 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. John 10:27-28 Jesus said unto her, "I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: and whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die." John 10:25-26 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. John 12:25 Then Jesus said unto them, "Yet a little while is the light with you. John 14:23 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. John 14:27 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. John 15:13 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. John 16:33 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. John 17:3 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. John 17:17 Jesus saith unto him, "Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed." John 20:29 Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, "Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons." Acts 10:34 We must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God. Acts 14:22 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; Romans 1:16 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 6:23 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. Romans 8:28 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
