

## The 6th Age: The Judgment of all Peoples.

We read about the sixth age in Eze chapters 40 through 48 and from many other major prophecies throughout the Bible.

During the sixth age many prophesied events will occur. Under Jesus, the final ruler, the whole earth will change to accommodate billions of peoples.

The dead will be resurrected and educated how to live long and happy lives by following God's instructions. As each group of people are resurrected, in their courses, they will be given a free will to choose eternal life or eternal death. If they choose God's way of life their names will be written in the Lamb's book of life. We are not told how long the sixth age will last but indications are long enough for all the dead to be resurrected and judged according to how they have/or will make choices. This, no doubt, will take thousands of years. No end of the world in sight by any means. We find in scripture that one is not held responsible for his or her sins unless they know what sin is. That doesn't mean that one will not suffer the consequences of sin.

Acts 17: 30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

31 Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead.

Many nations, since the beginning of creation, has never been educated to that extent, nor has God held them responsible; they have not received their judging. These will first have to know the difference and make a decision based on their understanding of God's will. Even now Paul says almost all of Israel are blinded. If they are spiritually blind they can't see. If they can't see they are not held responsible until their eyes are opened, then they will be held responsible. After they have proved themselves to be either Godly or ungodly, they will receive their judgment, either for eternal life or eternal death.

The Bible doesn't tell us at what time Satan is no longer on earth, but, in any case, he is controlled by Christ, who is King of kings. Satan will be allowed to test people as long as God chooses to use him as a tool for that purpose. (Rev.20:10) At the end of this sixth age the wicked will be dead with no further resurrections. The dead corpses of those who die will be burned up at the cleansing of the world with fire. (2Pet.3:7) Their bodies and their spirits will be utterly blotted out of existence. (Mat. 10:28, Rev. 20:14-15, 21:4) No one will die from this time forward. But even then, there still is no "end of time" here. Those remaining families that are saved and "held out to the end" will (be changed into spirit beings?) never die again.

Also we see in Rev.7:9-17 where great multitudes of different nationalities become servants of Christ in his Temple. This would of necessity have to be in the 6th age because there is no Temple in the 7th age. Rev.21:22-24) It also shows us that he has a Temple in the 6th age with a throne inside it from which he rules. This is the time, the law will come out of Jerusalem. Read about this age in Ezek. Chapters 40 through 48. Age 6 will be the very last civilization of mankind before a new age begins with a new heaven and a new earth as described in the last two chapters of Rev.

This also is the age when God cleanses Israel of all their sins and puts a new heart (spirit) in them and they will never, ever profane his name again.
